Laboratorium Olah Cerita dan Kisah (LOCK), is a program for Indonesian filmmakers to enhance their individual strength and originality in cinematic storytelling. The program consists of three clusters: a story development lab, an editing lab and networking activities with international as well as local players of the film scene. This combination will allow filmmakers to explore their inner potentials, as well as getting expert opinions and tap into relevant knowledge of international exposure.

Founded by Meiske Taurisia and Lisabona Rahman in 2019, LOCK is open for shorts and feature-length films, as well as both fiction and documentary projects. The selection process which follows an open call submission carefully considers the potentials of each proposed story, as well as the diversity of their sociocultural backgrounds, genre and production feasibility.

LOCK is organized by Cipta Citra Indonesian Foundation and fully supported by Indonesian Agency for Creative Economy (Badan Ekonomi Kreatif Indonesia/BEKRAF) in collaboration with First Cut Lab and Full Circle Lab.

Film is a sector in creative economy that has a fairly high degree of complexity since it involves multiple resources which include human, nature, creativity, technology, finance and it can create a direct impact to a country's economy while making a notable contribution to forming the identity of a diverse nation.

As a public agency working especially in developing creative economy, BEKRAF has the obligation to support the development of film, particularly in fulfilling the basic need of building filmmakers' capacity in creating their works. The agency supports a range of activities conducted in synergy at the local, national and international level through collaborations established with different partners and networks.

Laboratorium Olah Cerita dan Kisah is presented through a collaboration between BEKRAF and Cipta Citra Indonesia Foundation (YCCI) to explore fresh ideas for filmmaking and its diversity of expression. This is the effort from the government to improve the capacity of domestic filmmakers and to promote more

of them to the international scene. LOCK is a program for both feature-length and short filmmakers, documentary or fiction, from different regions of Indonesia. Selected participants of this program will have the opportunity to introduce their project at the AKATARA, Indonesian Film Financing Forum.

Besides programs for professional filmmakers, LOCK program also includes a public lecture which will provide the occasion for the public to share the knowledge and the experience brought to our country by the international partners.

I sincerely hope that this program could foster the growth of new talents in the film sector who will further enrich the range of films that has been featured by Indonesians in the domestic as well as world scenes.

Cipta Citra Indonesia Foundation (YCCI) initiated Laboratorium Olah Cerita dan Kisah (LOCK) for Indonesian filmmakers producing fiction and documentary films, in feature-length and short formats.

YCCI identifies a need to improve storytelling craft for Indonesian filmmakers so that they can always explore new potentials and boost the quality of their works to match the rapidly growing industry. Two crucial phases in story development, for fiction as well as documentary films, happens during the development stage of cinematic ideas and in the editing phase, particularly the offline editing. LOCK was created to improve work in these respective phases.

Several Indonesian filmmakers have clearly gained advantage of similar international development laboratories. Considering the abundance of potential talents in Indonesia and their diversity, YCCI feels the need to establish a collaboration with BEKRAF to create an international learning environment inside of the

country. It is indeed an advantage that Indonesia has such a public institution that supports initiatives in creative explorations and education in the film sector.

YCCI collaborates with First Cut Lab and Full Circle Lab which have created a team of diversely experienced international experts coming from France, Germany, Brazil and Egypt to offer a wider networking opportunity for Indonesian filmmakers. In the same week, YCCI also invites the attendance of local filmmaker associations to get to know the LOCK participants and establish a closer working relationships. The participants will also have the possibility to present their working results from LOCK at the upcoming AKATARA, Indonesian Film Financing Forum.

Thank you very much to everyone who has supported the creation of LOCK, hopefully this forum will bring good benefits to Indonesian filmmakers and the public.

Editing Lab

Teams in this category will have a plenary presentation of their respective rough cuts, followed by intensive review on their rough cut and consultations to achieve better narrative structure. The lab program also include peer review among fellow participants and planning future follow up possibilities.

Story Development Lab

Teams in this category will have discussions on their respective story ideas in three different levels: plenary presentation and discussions, peer consultation in smaller groups and individual consultation sessions.

Mini Sessions

Opportunities for industry professionals to meet, discuss current works or lessons learned from previous experiences and expand their respective international as well as domestic network.

Public Lecture

International mentors of the lab will take turns in sharing their experience and knowledge to the wider public. Each mentor specializes in different fields of filmmaking including story development, writing, directing, producing and editing. The public lecture is an opportunity to introduce the idea of an international collaboration in capacity building for filmmakers to a general audience.

The film is a bittersweet diary of Muhibah Angklung Orchestra, told by the dedicated but unorganized team leader Maulana, as they overcome whatever obstacles that attempted to stop them, as they won hearts and crossed boundaries through indomitable efforts and their music.

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
